she is sad/upset

(4) How could money 'go further' in the past? (line15) (2pts)

you could buy more for the same amount of money.

(5) What is the difference between the 'quality of life' and the 'standard of living'? (lines34-35 and 38) (2pts)

'the standard of living' is only economic - the money you earn and what it will buy! 'The quality of life' includes non-economic factors like safety, pollution and freedom.

(6) How many years have records been kept in Britain? Give a number. (2pts)

since 1914 - so 106 years in 2020.

(7) What is a 'single mum'? (line 62) (2pts)

a mother who is unmarried (or divorced, abandoned or widowed) and bringing up a child on her own.

(8) In what ways is life in ITALY today better or worse than it was 50 years ago? (3pts)
