Academic titles: After graduating at the Luiss Guido Carli University of Rome in 1993, Salvatore obtained his PhD in Private Law, Corporate Contracts (IX edition) at the University Federico II in Naples. He was researcher in Private Law at the University La Sapienza in Rome from 1999 to 2002. He received a scholarship for university researchers from the European Commission at the Humboldt Universität in Berlin, Germany (2000). Associate Professor of Private Law (2003-2018) and then Full Professor of Private Law (from 2019) at the University La Sapienza in Rome, Faculty of Economics, Department of Law and Economics for productive activities.

He is head of the Juridical Observatory on Digital Innovation (JODI) at the Department of Law and Economic Activities at the Rome University La Sapienza (Faculty of Economics).
