1. Written test (max 60 points)

The final score is obtained as the sum of the individual scores.

For passing the test, the candidate must reach at least a minimum score of 40/60.

2. Oral test (interview) (max 60 points)

Description Rating (Score):

Discussion on the themes of the respective curricula of the PhD (max 45): insufficient (0-29), sufficient (30-36), good (37-44), excellent (45).

Knowledge of English (max 15): insufficient (0-10), sufficient (11-12), good (13-14), excellent (15).

Final score obtained from the sum of the individual scores.

For passing the test, the candidate must score at least 40/60.
