The main aim of the SUMESLAND Summer School is to provide an interdisciplinary approach to education, with innovative teaching and learning methods, focusing on European island landscape and cultural heritage studies. SUMESLAND will help to disseminate the know-how acquired from the ESLAND Project of the EC Cultural Programme, and to support the implementation of the European Landscape Convention of the Council of Europe.

During the course, theory on landscape history, character, identity and scenarios will be taught, and e-tools and information technologies (i.e. GIS) will be demonstrated.

The SUMESLAND Summer School is free of charge for 10 selected students of Sapienza University of Rome. The 10 days of lectures and activities will take place in Sardinia. The first part will be held in Sassari and the second part on the island of Asinara. All classes will be in English.
