#### **Summary statement**

I am an academic physician and specialist in headache medicine. I trained first in physiology, and then in medicine at the University of London. Later I obtained Masters Degrees in law at Cardiff Law School, in medical ethics at the University of Wales and in business management at Imperial College Business School.

I have worked in the field of headache medicine for over 35 years. I am past-President of the European Headache Federation and past-General Secretary of the International Headache Society.
