ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/2020

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum admission requirements: Students must have successfully completed a Bachelor Degree (180 ECTS) in Economics studies and must be regularly enrolled in the first year of the Masters Degree in Economics and communication for management and innovation

Language requirements: Students have to demonstrate their proficiency in English language (level B2 or equivalent). Accepted certificates are:

- TOEFL: Test score of 87 or more
- IELTS (Academic module): minimum score of 6.5 in all skills
- TOEIC: 785(Listening/Reading 785; Speaking 160; Writing 150 all four skills required)
- CAE (Grade A,B or C)
- CPE (Grade A, B or C)
- Pearson English Test Academic (PTE-A): 59 points

Native speakers, applicants in whose country of origin English is the official language, applicants with a university degree from an English speaking country or applicants with a university degree for a program taught in English can be exempted upon request. Test results must be no more than 24 months old.

2. DEGREE

Upon successful completion of the Program requirements (120 ETCS), two separate diplomas will be conferred to the student according to the local regulations:

- The degree from Bucarest University shall be a Master Degree in "Entrepreneurship and Business Administration"
- The diploma from Sapienza University of Rome shall be a "Laurea Magistrale" in Economics and communication for management and innovation



3. STRUCTURE OF THE DOUBLE DEGREE

- **3.1** All the students enrolled in the Program from both institutions will attend the Master Degree in "Entrepreneurship and Business Administration" at Bucarest University and the "Laurea Magistrale" in Economics and communication for management and innovation at Sapienza.
- **3.2** For Sapienza Students the duration of mobility is two semesters (1st and 2nd semester of the 2nd year).
- **3.3** Before departure, students must have passed the exams of the first year according to the indications that will be provided by the Study Program Coordinator.
- **3.4** Exams taken at the host university will be recognized only if they correspond to those reported in the Learning Agreement and correspond to the subjects indicated in the following tables.

4. THESIS

- **4.1** The final thesis at the end of the second year must be presented at the home university. The home university will appoint a jury according to current regulations and the partner will appoint one assessor. This international jury will jointly assess the degree thesis.
- **4.2** Students must write their final thesis in English. A copy of the final thesis will be submitted to both institutions.
- **4.3** The Partners agree to mutually recognize the thesis done at the partner university, to accept the results of examination and the grade given.

5. FEES

- **5.1** Registration and tuition fees will be paid to Sapienza University.
- **5.2** Participation in the Double Degree Program is subject to the regular payment of fees.
- **5.3** Travel, living and other costs in the host Country, as well as those relating to the necessary insurance and study visas, are entirely borne by the students.



6. NUMBER OF OPEN POSITIONS

The maximum number of students that will participate in the Program will be five (5)

8. SELECTION

8.1 The applications are evaluated by a Commission chaired by the President of the Study Course.

The list of admitted students will be published on the study course website.

The selected candidates will be notified of the nomination and must confirm in writing the acceptance of the position.

8.2 The selected students must provide for the documentation and permits required for departure and requested by the host Country (passport, visa, invitation letter, accommodation, etc.).

Students in mobility are required to independently ensure adequate health coverage during their stay abroad and travel insurance, in the manner of the host Country.

Sapienza University isn't responsible and doesn't provide assistance for the completion of the above practices, which are the exclusive responsibility of the student.

9. STUDENTS' RIGHT AND DUTIES

9.1 All Program participants must meet the requirements established by Bucarest University of Economic Studies and Sapienza and will be subject to the academic and student regulations, policies and procedures of each institution while there in enrolled. Students participating in the Program shall be granted full access to both institutions' facilities (such as Library, Laboratories, etc.) during their studies.

10. SCHOLARSHIP

The selected students can benefit for a scholarship provided by the Sapienza International Office.

Students can take advantage of scholarship only once for each cycle of studies. The scholarship is not cumulable with other grants.

If selected, the student will still be able to participate in the Double Degree Program even if he is not entitled to the grant.
