1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum admission requirements: Students must have successfully completed a Bachelor Degree (180 ECTS) in Business Administration or Economics studies and must be regularly enrolled in the first year of the Masters Degree in "Intermediari, finanza internazionale e risk management" - Curriculum Banking and Finance

2. DEGREE

Upon successful completion of the Program requirements (120 ETCS), two separate diplomas will be conferred to the student according to the local regulations:

- The degree from HEC-ULg shall be a Master en Sciences de Gestion à finalité spécialisée en "Banking & Asset Management"
- The diploma from Sapienza University of Rome shall be a "Laurea Magistrale" in "Intermediari, finanza internazionale e risk management"

3. STRUCTURE OF THE DOUBLE DEGREE

- **3.1** All the students enrolled in the Program from both institutions will attend the first year at Sapienza and the second year at HEC-ULg.
- **3.2** For Sapienza Students the duration of mobility is one semesters and half, during the second year (6-10 months, depending on the internship).
- 3.3 Before departure (late September), students must have passed the exams of the first year (60 CFU).
- **3.4** Exams taken at the host university will be recognized only if they correspond to those reported in the Learning Agreement and correspond to the subjects indicated in the following tables.

3.5 The final thesis must be presented in the student's home institution. The home institution will appoint the jury according to the rules of the institution and the partner will appoint one assessor. This international jury will jointly assess the degree thesis.

4. FEES

- **4.1** Registration and tuition fees will be paid to Sapienza University.
- **4.2** Participation in the Double Degree Program is subject to the regular payment of fees.
- **4.3** Travel, living and other costs in the host Country, as well as those relating to the necessary insurance and municipality taxes, are entirely borne by the students.

5. NUMBER OF OPEN POSITIONS

The number of students that will participate in the Program will be four (4)

7. SELECTION

- **7.1** The applications are evaluated by a Commission chaired by the Responsible of DD Programs of the Study Course.
- 7.2 Within the first week of June, a provisional ranking list of eligible students will be published.

The selected candidates will be notified of the nomination and must confirm in writing the acceptance of the position by committing to conclude the exams of the first year within the summer session of the exams.

At the end of summer session of exam, the final ranking will be published and eligible students will became winner students.

7.3 The final ranking will be determined:





- for 50% by the score of the three-year degree curriculum (Bachelor Degree)
- for 10% by knowledge of the English language (level B2 for the English language)
- for 20% by the average mark of the exams scheduled in the first year, first semester of the master's degree course (Modelli matematici per le scelte di portafoglio; Politiche economiche europee; Risk management per le banche; Strategie, bilancio e performance della banca)
- for 20% by the average mark of the exams scheduled in the first year, second semester of the master's degree course (Diritto del mercato e degli strumenti finanziari; Pricing degli strumenti e dei servizi finanziari; Compliance e controlli interni nelle banche or Strumenti derivati)
- **7.4** Provisional and final rankings will be published on the website of the Study Course https://web.uniroma1.it/dip_management/double-degree/double-degree/double-degree

8. STUDENTS' RIGHT AND DUTIES

All Program participants must meet the requirements established by HEC-ULg and Sapienza and will be subject to the academic and student regulations, policies and procedures of each institution while there in enrolled. Students participating in the Program shall be granted full access to both institutions' facilities (such as Library, Laboratories, etc.) during their studies.

9. SCHOLARSHIP

The selected students can benefit for a scholarship provided by the Sapienza International Office.

Students can take advantage of scholarship only once for each cycle of studies. The scholarship is not cumulable with other grants.

If selected, the student will still be able to participate in the Double Degree Program even if he is not entitled to the grant.
