ACADEMIC YEAR 2019/2020

1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum admission requirements: Students must have successfully completed a Bachelor Degree (180 ECTS) in Economics studies and must be regularly enrolled in the first year of the Masters Degree in Business Management

Language requirements: Students have to demonstrate their proficiency in English language (level C1 or equivalent). Accepted certificates are:

- TOEFL: Test score of 87 or more
- IELTS (Academic module): minimum score of 6.5

Native speakers, applicants in whose country of origin English is the official language, or applicants with a university degree from an English speaking country can be exempted upon request.

2. DEGREE

Upon successful completion of the Program requirements (120 ECTS), two separate diplomas will be conferred to the student according to the local regulations:

- The degree from MGIMO shall be a Master Degree in “Digital Public Governance”
- The diploma from Sapienza University of Rome shall be a “Laurea Magistrale” in Economics and communication for management and innovation

4. THESIS

1. The final thesis at the end of the second year must be presented at the home or host university according to the number of students. The home/host university will appoint a jury according to current regulations and the partner will appoint one assessor. This international jury will jointly assess the degree thesis. MGIMO University does accept defence procedure conducted with the presence of the representative via skype conference with MGIMO jury commission.
2. Students must write their final thesis in English. A copy of the final thesis will be submitted to both institutions.
3. The Partners agree to mutually recognize the thesis done at the partner university, to accept the results of examination and the grade given.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Registration and tuition fees will be paid to Sapienza University.
- 4.2 Participation in the Double Degree Program is subject to the regular payment of fees.
- 4.3 Travel, living and other costs in the host Country, as well as those relating to the necessary insurance and study visas, are entirely borne by the students.

5. NUMBER OF OPEN POSITIONS

The maximum number of students that will participate in the Program will be **ten (10)**

9. SCHOLARSHIP

The selected students can benefit for a scholarship provided by the Sapienza International Office.
Students can take advantage of scholarship only once for each cycle of studies. The scholarship is not cummable with other grants.



If selected, the student will still be able to participate in the Double Degree Program even if he is not entitled to the grant.
