#### **Professional experience**

From December 1983 until graduation on 5-11-1984 Dr. Marcello Caratozzolo was an internal student of the Institute of IV Surgical Clinic of the University "Sapienza" in Rome at the Center of Ecotomographic Diagnostics directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini.

From the day after graduation until May 30 1987 Dr. Caratozzolo held the role of volunteer physician at the Chair of Technological Applications in Surgery directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini located at the Institute of IV Surgical Clinic of the University "Sapienza".

From July 1987 to May 1988, Dr. Caratozzolo served as a volunteer physician in the Department of General Surgery "Morgagni" of the Hospital St. Camillo directed by Prof. A. Bandini.

From June 1988 until 30 July 1990, Dr. Caratozzolo again served as a volunteer physician in the Chair of Technological Applications in Surgery directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini. From December 1990 until June 1997 he served as Assistant Surgeon and from June 1997 until November 1st 2002 he held the positions of I Level Executive in the Division of Applied Surgical Methodology directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini.

From November 1st 2002 to March 20, 2007, he held the position of I Level Executive at the U.O.C. of General Surgery H, Director Prof. Marcello Bezzi.

From the first recruitment at the Chair of General Surgery directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini (July 30, 1990) was personally responsible for the Interventional Ultrasound and Ultrasound Diagnostics Clinic first at the Special Service of Applied Surgical Methodology of the Umberto I Polyclinic in Rome, directed by Prof. Licinio Angelini (until November 2002) and then at the

U.O.C. of General Surgery H, directed by Prof. Marcello Bezzi, where he carried out procedures of eco-guided intervention for external outpatient patients, for patients admitted to the Polyclinic Umberto I or coming from other Roman Hospitals (San Giovanni, Ospedale Militare Celio, Ospedale di Palestrina, S. Spirito, ecc...).

The case study of Dr. Marcello Caratozzolo, concerning interventional acts carried out under ultrasound guidance, includes about 8000 biopsies (hepatic, kidney, pancreatic, prostate, abdominal masses, etc.), at least 10000 fine needle aspiration citology of all organs surface and non-surface (thyroid breast spleen abdominal lymph nodes etc...) in addition to various drainages

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(abdominal collections, liver abscesses, kidney cysts, nephrostomy) and ablation treatments of primitive or secondary liver lesions with alcohol or radiofrequency.

From February 1995 to September 1997, Dr. Marcello Caratozzolo also participated in the operating room activity, participating in laparoscopic surgery carried out on patients admitted to the Division of Surgical Methodology Applied and also performing as the first surgeon some interventions of laparoscopic cholecystectomy.

From March 21, 2007 to 2010, he was a member of the U.O.C. of Central Radiology B, directed by Prof. Vincenzo Tombolini, in the Department of Radiological Sciences and from 2011 to today is inserted into the U.O.C. Head-Neck directed by the Prof. Ferdinando D'Ambrosio and is part of the Department of Radiological, Oncological and Anatomo-Pathological Sciences at the Umberto I Polyclinic, where he mainly deals with Diagnostic and Interventional Ultrasound.
