



Global CIVIS days 2020 Student hackathon programme

hackathon overview

What is the CIVIS student hackathon?

The CIVIS student hackathon is a thematic event on climate, environment and energy (Hub1) during which students from CIVIS member universities will work collectively on a joint project with the objective of bringing an innovative approach, idea or solution to a given challenge.

How is the hackathon organised?

The student hackathon will take place online through a dedicated platform on <https://www.civisdays.civis.eu/en>.

When will the student hackathon take place?

The event will be held on **Monday 9th** and **Tuesday 10th November 2020**. Participants will have 24 to 30 hours to collaborate via the online platform and build a solution within the challenge areas.

What challenges will the students take part in?

There are **3 challenge categories**: Green Erasmus, Green campus, SDGs in Education. During the registration and team up phase, students will have to choose a category to participate in.

For each challenge category, a specific problem will be sent out to the teams, in the form of a question, on the day of the event (9 Nov):

Green Erasmus: how can I make my Erasmus+ exchange carbon neutral?

Green campus: How can university campuses be more sustainable?

SDGs in Education: How can we use the SDGs to help guide more solution-oriented educational programmes?
