eOSCE DOMINOS will start soon!

The **Objective Structured Clinical Examination** (OSCE) is a clinical skills assessment often used in the health sciences, designed in a standardized way and covering the performance of procedures, the ability to communicate with a patient or other professionals.

The **Erasmus+ DOMINOS project**, in which our Faculty is involved promotes **digital OSCEs** (eOSCE) at the European level, through a **learning platform**, so as to harmonize preparation in the Medicine and Pharmacy curricula. In addition to a usable collection of eOSCE stations, we provide online tools to increase student preparation for exams, with synchronous sessions (in Zoom) and asynchronous Serious Games, to train "where and when you want."
