The traditional event "Sapienza Open Days" this year has a special English edition, which will be live via Zoom and live-streaming on Youtube at 2:00 p.m. (CEST) on **June the 6th 2024**. This event is especially dedicated to international students who are thinking of taking degrees in the Health Sciences at Sapienza University of Rome starting next academic year. Academic representatives of the Health Sciences (i.e. Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine, Medicine and Dentistry, Medicine and Psychology) will meet online with students from around the world, who are interested in degrees delivered entirely in English, starting in the next academic year. The offer includes degree programs in Medicine and Surgery, Dentistry and Dental Prosthodontics, or Nursing. Presidents of the degree programs, faculty members and tutors as well present international students, will participate in the event. Secretarial staff will be on hand to provide administrative information. A Q&A session will be devoted to the most important, commonly-shared and practical issues related to studying Medicine, Dentistry or Nursing in Rome. The screening of videos illustrating different moments of university life will provide additional information.

La Sapienza is ranked among the top 100 universities worldwide, disputing the podium for those in Italy. The Faculties of Health Sciences contribute significantly to this performance and offer an international and globally competitive environment in research, clinical practice and teaching. No competing university, however, offers a city life like Rome, the social and climatic conditions of southern Europe at such a low cost. The opportunity to study medical disciplines in English at Sapienza is well-worth considering and a very appropriate solution for those who intend to pursue European-level higher education in the field of health care.

The Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility (ICM) offers opportunities to study in non-EU countries selected by the program.



Study Biochemistry at Sapienza

Our Faculty, in collaboration with the Faculty of Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences has activated a **master degree** (second cycle) program in **Biochemistry**, entirely delivered in English. Our Biochemistry degree was the first to be established in Italy in a.y. 2021-2022.

The biochemist is a worldwide valued and recognized professional figure that applies a multidisciplinary molecular and chemical approach to the study of biological processes and metabolism in living organisms and that importantly contributes to the development of many biotechnological fields. The work of the biochemists has indeed relevance in Industrial as well as Environmental and Agrofood Biotechnologies.

Scholarships for thesis work abroad

Did you know that every year Sapienza makes available scholarships to support your mobility to carry out thesis work abroad?

Scholarships are awarded following a competition advertised by the Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine typically middle-late spring of each year. Stay tuned and check for the publication of the call at <u>this link</u> by selecting "borse di studio" and filtering by Faculty and year.

The scholarships for thesis abroad are aimed to support students at least in the first year of the master's or specialist degree course, in the penultimate or last year of a single-cycle master who wish to carry out part of their thesis work abroad at academic institutions, EU or non-EU companies, or at supranational or international institutions of adequate scientific and cultural level. Also students in the first year "fuori corso" can apply".

The thesis work abroad must be carried out for a period of at least two consecutive months. The scholarship is typically 2,821.00 euros gross (including IRAP).

Erasmus+ ICM

Funded by the European Commission, the Erasmus+ ICM (International Credit **Mobility**) program allows students to spend a period of study in **non-EU countries**. Following the publication of a call, selected students receive a scholarship of 700 euros per month, plus are covered for travel expenses.

Please note: that the destinations can change from year to year.

All scholarship holders will be able to attend courses at the host university without having to pay tuition fees. Furthermore, all the activities carried out abroad will be recognized by Sapienza because they are based on a Learning Agreement signed by the interested parties, just as it happens for Erasmus+ mobility in EU countries. Student mobility can last from a minimum of 3 to a maximum of 6 months, but an extension is also possible (up to 12 months).
