



# INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLES 12, 13 AND 14 OF THE GDPR (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION) 2016/679 AND CURRENT NATIONAL LEGISLATION

# 1. Subject

Information pursuant to art. 12, 13 and 14 of EU Regulation n. 2016/679 (henceforth also referred to as GDPR) and current national legislation. We wish to inform you, as "Data Subject", that your personal data and the company/association you represent will be processed, in compliance with the above mentioned legislation.

#### 2. Data Controller

## 4. Purpose of processing

finalists and winners on:

The data is treated by Centro di Ricerca ImpreSapiens in order to participate in the Business Innovation Hub Challenge in the manner indicated in the Rules of the Challenge itself, of which this information is attached, in compliance with the current regulatory framework. The data will be used exclusively for the purposes provided, within the provisions of laws, regulations or contractual rules, namely:

- a) allow participation in the Challenge and carry out all the necessary related activities provided for in the Regulation, by way of example: i) administrative management, ii) identification of winners, iii) notification to participants of the results of the competition; b) publish the personal data (name, surname and city of residence and/or image) of the
  - Social media platforms and websites managed by Centro di Ricerca ImpreSapiens;
  - Press releases of Centro di Ricerca ImpreSapiens.





In relation to participation in the Challenge, Centro di Ricerca ImpreSapiens acquires and processes "common" personal data referred to in Article 4, point 1 of the GDPR: personal data (name, surname, date and place of birth); contact data (company headquarters, website, email address, linkedin profile); data related to the proposed Project, data related to photos/images.

Please note that the source of the processed data lies in the statements made by you and, in general, by the subjects listed above and that the data processed may also come from sources accessible to the public.

# 5. Processing and storage methods

The personal data collected and processed are as follows:

- personal data;
- data necessary for the identification of the finalists and winners of the Challenge;
- data related to university career and/or other active roles held with Sapienza University of Rome;
- data provided from time to time by candidates.

These data are processed exclusively for the pursuit of the institutional purposes of Sapienza, in particular for the fulfillment required by law for the purpose of the conduct of the competition.

# 6. Potential recipients or categories of recipients of data

The Data may be communicated to third parties, in accordance with national and European legislation in force, in particular to the internal offices of Sapienza.

The data will be processed manually and/ or through computer and telematic tools, with logic of organization and processing of data related to the purposes indicated above and, in any case, in order to ensure the security and confidentiality of data.

The management and storage of personal data collected for the purposes indicated in this information is carried out on servers located within the University and/ or external providers of certain services necessary for technical management - administrative that, for the sole purpose of the requested service, may become aware of the personal data of the data subjects and that are duly appointed as Data Processors pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR.

## 7. Obligation of data provision by the data subject

The provision of data is mandatory. Any refusal to provide data may result in failure to perform a task in the public interest. Failure to provide data implies the impossibility for the Data Controller, the Data Controller and the persons in charge of carrying out the data processing operations and, therefore, the impossibility of providing the related services requested.

In particular, failure to provide data precludes the establishment and continuation of the relationship with Sapienza University of Rome.

# 8. Recipients

# 9. Rights of the Data Subject

Please note that the data subject may ask the Data Controller for access to personal data pursuant to art. 15 of the Regulation, the rectification of the same pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulation, the cancellation of the same pursuant to art. 17 of the Regulation (where the latter does not conflict with the current legislation on the storage of data and the need to protect, in the event of legal disputes, the University and the professionals who have processed them) or the restriction of processing pursuant to art. 18 of the Regulation, or you can oppose their processing pursuant to art. 21 of the Regulation, in addition to exercising the right to data portability pursuant to art. 20 of the Regulation.

## 10. How to exercise your rights and complain to the Data Protection Authority

Without prejudice to the above, the data subject may assert his rights pursuant to Articles 15-22 of the GDPR using the contact data indicated on p. 1 of this policy.
