Overview

Medicine and Art: red shoes at the Sapienza aims to create a forum for debate among universities, schools and civil society on the theme of violence against women. Our educational programme involves students from faculties of Medicine who need to understand the full complexity of violence against women order to deal with it in their working lives. It also involves raising high school students' awareness to a level which will help them prevent violence against women and eliminate it at a cultural level in the future.

Participation in the project is **free** for schools, artists and associations and is officially recognized by Sapienza University, Rome.

There will be two exhibitions – an online exhibition of digital artwork and a live exhibition.

Digital artwork – online exhibition

The aim of our exhibitions is to raise awareness and spread a clear antiviolence message. We therefore invite artists of all ages to express themselves creatively on this subject. Any form of artistic expression can be used as long as it can be reproduced digitally.

Live exhibition

On 25 November 2022, a live exhibition will be held at a venue at Sapienza University, Rome. Artwork should conform to the size limits required by the venue (to be decided).
