The European Society for Neurochemistry (ESN) is delighted to invite you to the 23rd *ESN Biennial Meeting and 7th Conference on Molecular Mechanisms of Regulation in the Nervous System,* which will be held in *Milan (Italy) on September 1-4, 2019*.

The Meeting will take place at the Università degli Studi di Milano which is one of the largest Universities in Italy. More than 400 investigators at the University are directly involved in neuroscience research. Scientific sessions will be held in the main historical building of the University, the "Ca' Granda", located very close to the main attractions of the city. The Ca' Granda is an excellent location for conferences with up to 700 participants.

ESN members, and researchers interested to join ESN, are invited to send proposals for plenary lectures, symposia, mini-symposia and workshops for the meeting.

The International Programme Committee aims to generate a highly interesting and attractive program for the meeting, covering wide areas of neurochemistry research, stimulate scientific interchange, identify new "hot" topics and help to develop new concepts. With your help, we will be able to organize a highly attractive scientific meeting that will give the participants an opportunity to present and discuss their new data in cellular and molecular neuroscience.

The Programme will consist of Plenary Lectures (Opening Plenary Lecture, the ISN-sponsored Lecture and the Bachelard Award Lecture), the Symposium "Meet the Professor" (3 speakers); the "Young Members' Symposium" (selected by the Scientific Committee from the applications - the Call will be announced in due course); the "ESN Young Scientist Lectureship Award" (selected from received nominations – the Call will be announced in due course); Symposia with invited speakers on the topics selected from the proposals (4 speakers in each symposium); Mini-Symposia (3 speakers in each minisymposium), Workshops.

- 3. Abstract (description of the topic of the symposium and how it relates to the conference focus up to 1000 characters)
- 4. Speakers (names, tentative titles of the talks, affiliations, short CV with a list of main publications, contact addresses, provisional agreement to speak)
