Project Outline

The International Seminary of architectural design reflects on the past changes, present and future in architecture, in the cities and in the territory. Reflections on architectural transformations, urban and territorial which take account of historical events, cultures and places, involving the legacy of tradition, the contemporary action and openness to new proposals in the perspective of sustainability. The Seminar has scientific targets related to disciplinary and inter-change research: change of use for recovery (rehabilitation) of areas, urban spaces and degraded buildings in ancient urban contexts, open to new ways of living (type-morphological studies) , to new computing technologies, energy resources and renewable energy sources to green spaces and the balance among architecture, urban landscape and nature. Scientific research, best design, practice and teaching are relevant aspects of the workshop.

The workshop aims

- The cultural exchange among the different schools of architecture and different practices.
- The close examination of the urban project, architectural, of the interiors and of the settings in various scales for the economic and cultural recovery of historical contexts.
- The interdisciplinarity among the different project levels from the sustainability’s point of view.
- Integrated project for the historic heritage.
- Balance among architecture, urban and natural landscape, among poetic, technique and ethics.

Nature and goals

The International workshop is addressed to professional engineers and architects, to the students of the supporting faculties of Architecture and Engineering of the event. It is finalized to the definition of a Master Plan on different scales to which can correlate close examinations of the urban planning project, architectural project, and of the restoration addressed to the recovery of areas, urban spaces, and degraded buildings in the ancient urban contexts of Narni (TR), that strongly requires new proposals for an immediate recovery aimed at identifying new useful functions revitalizing the overall development re-launching of local economies and for the improvement of the urban quality.

Description of the seminary activities

The international Seminar will take place from July 22th to July 29st 2011. Teaching activity is scheduled as follows:

- Conferences and meetings opened to all the participants.
- Communications related to each group's work theme.
- Assisted teaching design activity from professors and tutors.
- Trips on the sites.

Participation certificate

At the completion of the international seminary, each participant will be having a participation certificate with the relative credits.

Where it will take place

The international seminar will be held in Narni (Terni, Umbria ,Italy) at the S. Domenico building of the University, via Mazzini 27, in the town centre.

Enrollments and fees

The Workshop is opened to Architects and Engineers, to students of the three/year degree, specialized school and the five/year E.U. major from the schools of Architecture and Engineering.

The fee for the enrolment is of 400.00 euros and includes 9 nights (from Thursday 21rd , to Friday night ,29st of july), tutorial material and meal tickets.
