If you are a BA, MA or PhD student interested in **multilingualism** and multiculturalism, apply for our Blended Intensive Program, carried out by 7 European and 2 North-African universities. You will be trained to innovative **fieldwork methodology** for gathering data about the languages of people and places, past and present, and will contribute to the growth of EUROTALLES, a collaborative Museum/Lab that displays the languages of our communities.

Successful applicants will be offered a mobility grant and travel to Rome, and will be awarded **6 ECTS**.

Virtual lectures and workshops: 20 hours (10 weekly appointments on Fridays, 2PM CEST, from November 3rd, 2023 to December 15th, 2023)

Physical mobility in Rome: 20 hours (**4 hours a day of activities - fieldwork, seminars, conversations with writers and scholars**, from January 8th to January 12th, 2024)
