- defend our ideas.

There will be space to share work in a cosy, friendly atmosphere, and I will make sure everyone receives personalised feedback.

Although, naturally, writing is not always easy, I'd like people to associate it mainly with the joy brought by discoveries and dialogue, not with exhaustion. And, most importantly, I'd like people to see that they are not alone in writing – that sitting in an empty room and staring at a cursor blinking on a blank page is not what writing is about.
