APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Premise	École normale supérieure is a selective and challenging institution; a very high level of the partners' students is requested, according to the academic standards of E.N.S. The students should feel at ease with professors and with students: they should be good enough to validate their study program in E.N.S. First and Second-Year Undergraduate students are not admitted.
Scientific coordination	The students' mobility has to be managed by the coordinator of the exchange program in the sending institution.
Admission	The student's schedule (<i>fiche</i>) with his study program and personnal project has to be accepted by E.N.S. It should first be submitted to the approbation of the student's desired tutor and of the professor in charge with foreign students in the selected department (<i>Correspondant de la Direction des Relations Internationales</i>). The files (<i>fiche</i> and copies of the acceptations) are to be sent directly by the partner institution to Martine Bimut (in charge with ITALY Program: martine.bismut@sns.it) and to dri@ens.fr .
