Programs for Exchange Students:

▪ Regular Academic Programs at NTNU

Undergraduate and graduate courses in all subjects (Please note that some courses with special requirements are upon lecturer's permission).

▪ International Culture Program (ICP)

The ICP courses are to be supplemented by credit-bearing language courses in Chinese, which will provide students with a set of balanced curricula that include both culture and language. It's a series of culture-related courses that are exclusively taught in English. The categories of courses are "*Literature and Arts*", "*Introduction to Chinese Traditional Culture*", "*Readings in Chinese and Western Art*"...etc.

▪ Chinese Language Courses:

Non-Mandarin-speaker exchange students are eligible to take semester program up to 6 hours per week without charge in **Mandarin Training Center**.

Accommodation	Availability of on-campus dorm room is limited and application needed. Rent : NT\$17,000~NT\$23,000 per semester (Electricity is charged extra).
Visa Requirements	For one-semester students: Study LESS than 6 months can apply <u>VISITOR VISA</u> , then apply for extension within 15 days before the duration expired. For one-year students: Study MORE than 6 months can apply <u>RESIDENT VISA</u> , and are required to apply Alien Resident Certificates (ARC) within 15 days after arrival.
Medical Insurance	All exchange students are required to buy Student Group Insurance while their exchange period in NTNU. NTNU offers a medical insurance which covers basic medical expenses, pay-as-you-go, claim up to NT\$1,000.
Living costs in Taipei	Approximate living costs : NT\$8,000-12,000 per month (exclude housing and)

Semester Program

Course Description:

- Non-Chinese-speaking exchange students can take MTC semester program (group class) up to 6 hours per week with charge.
- If students want to take courses other than semester program or more than 6 hours per week, they will need to pay for the tuition (with a 20% discount).
- This course only counts for learning hours, no credits provided.
- It's a non-compulsory courses.

Course Feature:

Under the instruction of professional Mandarin Chinese teachers.
Each class of 8~15 students, will meet twice per week.
Class levels range from beginner to Intermediate.
A placement test is required.
