In particular, my scientific work is related to the processes of dyadic coping, which can promote or limit personal and relational well-being both in everyday life and in facing major stressors such as COVID-19 and divorce. The topics are analysed with the use of qualitative and quantitative methods, such as the thematic analysis and the dyadic data analysis, methods useful to detect the complexity of the relationships.
