ART. 1 - PURPOSES

Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training youth and sports in force for the period 2021-2027 allowing international experience and the acquisition of new competencies. The Erasmus+ programme supports the mobility of students, PhD students and specialisation programme students for a study period abroad during which:

- **attend educational activities** (lectures) and pass the relevant proficiency assessments/tests (exams);
- combine a study period with a curricular internship period (only if provided for in the educational programme)
- conducting research for the preparation of the degree programme's dissertation and/or doctoral thesis
- conducting research within the framework of the relevant doctorate or specialisation school.

At the end of the mobility period, full recognition of successful educational and/or research activities undertaken abroad is guaranteed, **provided that they have been approved in advance through the Learning Agreement/Change Form**¹ (see Article 9 below).

ART. 2 - TYPES AND DURATIONS OF MOBILITY

1. The duration of the mobility is defined by the inter-institutional agreement between Sapienza and the partner universities.

Study periods abroad, intended as physical mobility, may start **on June 1, 2024**, must end by **July 31, 2025**, and **must be carried out <u>continuously.</u>**

- 2. Mobility can be of 2 types:
- a. Mobility Erasmus *LONG MOBILITY* for STUDENTS in first and second-cycle degree programmes, PhD students and STUDENTS in specialisation schools, it has a **minimum duration of 2 months (60 days) and a maximum duration of 12 months** (24 months in the case of a single-cycle degree programme) and can be carried out in all the universities of the Programme Countries and Partner Countries.

The duration may vary only for justified academic reasons in the event that:

- the duration of the semesters does not coincide with the academic calendar of the international venue:
- the student has already benefited from mobility periods in the same study cycle. In this case, the maximum duration will be reduced to the remaining months with respect to the maximum limit of 12 months per study cycle (and 24 months for single-cycle degrees), subject to the authorisation of the host institution

b. Mobility Erasmus **SHORT MOBILITY** only for PhD STUDENTS:

The *short mobility*, which **may be carried out only by students enrolled on PhD courses**, must have a minimum duration of 5 days and a maximum of 30 days and must <u>only</u> take place at <u>Programme Countries</u>.

ART. 3 - DESTINATIONS

It is possible to undertake Erasmus mobility for study at universities with which Sapienza has stipulated an inter-institutional agreement and belonging to one of the following country groups:

- **Programme Countries** which include all EU Member States, as well as Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Turkey, Serbia and the Republic of North Macedonia;
- Partner Countries: United Kingdom and Switzerland.

ART. 3.1 - MOBILITY TO CIVIS ALLIANCE UNIVERSITIES

The activities referred to in Article 1 can also be carried out at universities participating in the CIVIS European Alliance, "A European Civic University https://www.uniroma1.it/en/civis-european-civic-university. CIVIS Alliance universities offer mobility opportunities for all degree programmes in their faculties and integrated welcome services Students - CIVIS - A European Civic University).

ART. 3.2 - MOBILITY WITHIN DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- 1. By applying for this call for applications, it is also possible to receive support for the study period abroad required to obtain the Italian qualification and the international qualification for degree programmes that provide for this possibility https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/double-multiple-and-joint-degrees.
- 2. Terms and conditions for participation vary depending on the international venue, year of enrolment/attendance, and academic requirements and are regulated in specific agreements.
- 3. Students wishing to participate in mobility within the double-degree pathways may only apply to this call for applications **for the venues reserved for these pathways** (see Article 3.3 "AVAILABLE VENUES AND PLACES").

ART. 4 - TUITION FEES AND ECONOMIC BENEFITS

Mobility students are **exempt** from paying tuition fees **at the host university** but must continue to pay tuition fees to Sapienza University of Rome.

ART. 4.1 - MONTHLY ERASMUS + GRANT

1. The amount of the grant awarded from Erasmus+ Programme resources varies according to the type of mobility (Long mobility or Short mobility) and the <u>cost of living</u> in the destination country as well as the <u>actual days of mobility abroad</u> certified by the partner university

- 2. The Erasmus+ grant is incompatible with other grants from other EU-funded programmes/actions.
- 3. If the Erasmus+ funds run out or if the student is simultaneously awarded other EU funding (including PhD programmes funded with PON, PNRR or other types of EU funding for doctoral studies) or University funding for the same activity, for example for thesis research, it is possible to grant the student the status of "Erasmus zero eu-grant": in this way, the student may benefit from the facilities provided by the Erasmus+ programme (e.g. exemption from payment of tuition fees at the host university, Erasmus+ student status and supplementary monthly grant from Sapienza/MUR as per art. 4.2), without receiving the EU grant.





ART. 4.2 - SAPIENZA/MUR SUPPLEMENTARY MONTHLY GRANT

1. Mobility beneficiaries **enrolled up to the first year** *fuoricorso* may also receive a monthly supplementary grant from Sapienza and the Ministry for University and Research ("*Fondo Giovani M.U.R.*") quantified on the basis of the beneficiary's **ISEE 2023** acquired on Infostud at the deadline for applying (in the event of lack of the latter, the Isee 2024 may be acquired):

Students and/or PhD students and students in specialisation schools who are exempt, for any reason, from submitting the ISEE for the payment of tuition fees, to benefit from the supplementary grant referred to in this article, **must**, **in any case**, **acquire the ISEE 2023 on Infostud (in the event of lack of the latter, ISEE 2024 may be acquired).**

- 2. The ISEE value available on Infostud on the day following the deadline for submitting applications will be taken into consideration for the purposes of quantifying the supplementary grant. If no ISEE value is available, the supplementary grant will be awarded at the rate foreseen for the maximum range > € 55,000.00.
- 3. For participants with tax residence abroad, including DiscoLazio grant-holders with tax residence abroad, the supplementary grant will be differentiated on the basis of the country in which the income is generated, according to the grant brackets set out in the resolution of the Board of Governors of May 30, 2023, as follows:

The presentation of the equal ISEE will therefore not be allowed.

- 4. The supplementary grant referred to in this article may be granted only if:
 - a) the beneficiaries <u>have paid for enrolment at Sapienza for the 2024/2025 academic year</u>, unless the beneficiary is a graduating student in the 23-24 academic year (by January 31, 2025);

- b) First-cycle and second-cycle students are enrolled within the first year *fuoricorso* (for the calculation, reference will be made to the year of enrolment at Sapienza, even in the case of degree programme transfer).
- c) The beneficiaries manage to obtain by November 30, 2025, the recognition in their educational career of at least <u>12 ECTS</u> (reduced to 3 ECTS for students who exclusively carry out research activities for the preparation of their thesis and to 10 ECTS for the qualifying internship). The above does not apply to PhD students and students in Specialisation Schools.

Students who do not obtain the recognition referred to in paragraph 5 letter c) above **will be asked to return any supplementary grant already paid** and to cancel any integrations. Recognition within the educational career must be completed exclusively by following the digitalised procedures via the personal Erasmus page, which requires validation by the Academic Supervisor for International Mobility (see Article 8).

ART. 4.3 INTEGRATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AND/OR SPECIAL NEEDS

- 1. **Additional funds** are available to support students with disabilities and/or special needs. Students interested should indicate the disability/special need, both at the application stage and at the mobility acceptance stage, in order to receive instructions on how to apply for dedicated funding, as indicated on the webpage: http://www.uniroma1.it/erasmus/studenti-students/erasmus-studenti-diversamente-abili.
- 2. The payment of the grant for special needs is subject to approval by the Erasmus+ National Agency *Indire*. In the event that financial coverage is not available in whole or in part, the student will have to bear the costs independently.

ART. 5 – APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

ART. 5.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. To apply you must:
 - be **enrolled** (including on part-time status) at Sapienza University of Rome, in the academic year 2023/2024 in a bachelor's degree, master's degree, single-cycle degree, PhD or specialisation school;
 - renew enrolment at Sapienza University of Rome for the academic year 2024/2025 within the deadlines set by the University;
- 2. Students who, in the academic year 2023/2024, plan to graduate within the 2025 extraordinary graduation session and carry out their mobility during the subsequent Master's degree programme, may do so during the first year of their Master's degree programme exclusively in the second semester 2024-25, provided that the chosen venue provides for the second-cycle programme and congruent educational activities. In this case, if the chosen venue provides for mobility beyond the semester, mobility will be reduced ex officio.
- 3. Since Erasmus+ mobility <u>may be carried out for a total period not exceeding 12 months for each cycle of studies</u> (bachelor's degree, master's degree, PhD and specialisation school, 24 months for single-cycle degree programmes), even if carried out at another university, by





submitting an application for the Erasmus+ call for students for the academic year 2024/2025, candidates confirm that they have a number of remaining months of study congruent with the above-mentioned rule³.

Any grants received for a number of months in excess of the above-mentioned limit must be returned, without prejudice to the further civil and penal consequences deriving from the issue of false declarations pursuant to art. 76 of D.P.R. December 28, 2000 no. 445.

ART. 5.2 – ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

1. Students who meet the following academic requirements may apply to this call for applications:

Students enrolled in a first level degree course (CdL) must:

- a) Be enrolled in the first year of the course or subsequent years of the New Regulation.
- b) Having acquired at least 18 ECTS credits if in the first year, at least 36 ECTS credits if in the second year, and at least 60 ECTS credits if in the third year. The credits must be acquired in compliance with any preparatory constraints established by the law;
- c) have an average of 22/30;
- d) Three-year degree students enrolled in years subsequent to the first must have taken the Economia politica exam (for the Degree Course in *Economia e Finanza*) and the Economia Aziendale exam (for the Degree Courses in *Scienze aziendali* and in *Economia dell'innovazione*):
- e) Three-year degree students cannot take first-year fundamental exams abroad.

Students enrolled in a second level degree course (CdLS) and (CDLM) must:

- a) Having acquired at least 18 ECTS credits if in the first year, at least 36 ECTS credits if in the second or subsequent years; The credits must be acquired in compliance with any preparatory constraints established by the law.
- b) have an average of 26/30.

Master's degree students who, by the deadline date of the announcement, have less than 45 ECTS credits to acquire, excluding those relating to their degree thesis, cannot apply.

2. In the selection process, only credits (ECTS) that have been acquired **and recorded on Infostud** by the deadline for submitting the application form will be taken into consideration and evaluated.

The student is allowed to integrate with a self-certification (see the appropriate section of the application form) exams that have been recorded but not yet certified (i.e. those for which the professor has not yet digitally signed the report).

- 3. Both for the academic knowledge assessment and for any assessment in terms of points awarded, the following exams will not be taken into account:
 - a. exams taken abroad during the Erasmus stay for which the validation procedure has not yet been completed;

- b. extracurricular profit exams pursuant to Article 6 of RD no. 1269/38 as these exams do not contribute to the achievement of the ECTS required to obtain the degree;
- c. integrated exams and *ADE*s (elective educational activities) if the credits (ECTS) relating to all the subjects constituting each integrated exam have not been obtained;
- d. exams taken as "single courses" if these have not already been recognised within the degree programme, or single-cycle degree programme in which the student is enrolled for the current academic year;
- e. cancelled exams due to non-compliance with propaedeuticities;
- f. exams declared as having been taken and which turn out to be only booked and not taken, or not booked at all.

ART. 5.3- LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

1. A minimum level of language proficiency **equal to level A2** of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) recognised by the Council of Europe is required at the application stage https://www.coe.int/en/web/common-european-framework-reference-languages.

Language proficiency must be proven, alternatively:

- with the test result(s) passed <u>before completing</u> the online application during one of the sessions held from September 2023 to February 2024 at the <u>Sapienza Language Centre (CLA)</u>. The modalities are described in Annexe 1;
- by the fulfilment of one of the requirements permitting exemption from the test, as set out in Article **5.3.1 "LANGUAGE TEST EXEMPTION".**
- 2. Most international universities require a **specific, additional level of language proficiency**, which must be demonstrated at the time of departure in the form stipulated by the host university. The additional language proficiency can be acquired independently by the student or through attendance of *CLA* language courses.

ART. 5.3.1 – LANGUAGE TEST EXEMPTION

- 1. Students who meet one of the following requirements are exempt from taking the *CLA* language test:
 - a. Having passed the test at CLA in the case of a previous application for the ERASMUS+ 2023/2024 call for applications. Students who do not wish to take advantage of this exemption may choose to take the test again. In this case, the new result obtained (lower, higher or failed test for the language in which the test is repeated) will replace the previous one;
 - b. Be **native speakers**⁴ of the language chosen for the mobility having completed at least the entire course of primary and secondary education in the country whose language they intend to practise, at state or private (recognised) schools of the same nationality. Students wishing to take advantage of this exemption **must provide a copy of the Diploma** obtained or other suitable documentation to prove that they fall under point b. Native Language corresponds to level C2 of the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
 - c. Having attained a minimum level of language proficiency equal to at least level A2, attested by an official certificate issued by one of the certifying bodies listed in the CEFR comparability table (https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/erasmus-calls-study-2024-

- <u>25</u> Language certificates recognised for the purposes of the Erasmus+ calls for study academic year 2024/2025), for the language(s) chosen for mobility.
- d. be enrolled in degree programmes taught entirely in English at Sapienza University if English is the language required for the purposes of mobility. Students will be exempt from taking the test only if the level of English required for their degree programme is equal to or higher than the level required by the international institution.
- e. Having obtained an **upper secondary school diploma from an international high school recognised by the Ministry of University and Research** for the languages English, French (ESABAC diploma), German, Spanish or Portuguese (an upper secondary school diploma from an international high school corresponds to level B2).
- f. Having obtained, during a mobility period in the **academic year 2023/2024**, a minimum level of language proficiency of A2 for one of the languages listed in Annexe 1, by means of a language proficiency certificate issued by the **Language Centre of the host university.**
- g. To be bilingual where the second language is the one chosen for the purposes of mobility, or to have completed at least the entire primary and secondary education cycle in Regions with a special statute or in Autonomous Provinces where bilingualism is in force according to the regional statutes applicable. Students wishing to make use of this exemption may declare this by self-certification in accordance with Presidential Decree no. 445/2000.
- 2. In the event that the student intends to apply for a venue **that requires a higher level of language proficiency** than the above-mentioned cases, or for a **venue where a language other than the certified language is required**, the student must take the test at *CLA*.
- 3. **Language qualifying exams** passed as part of the student's degree programme **do NOT exempt** them from taking the assessment test at *CLA*. Similarly, statements issued by lecturers, including university lecturers, or the passing of curricular language exams will not be considered suitable for participation in the call for applications.

ART. 5.3.2 – LANGUAGE TESTS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES AND SPECIFIC LEARNING DIFFICULTIES

- 1. Candidates with disabilities as defined in Article 3 of Law no. 104 of 1992 and/or a disability equal to or greater than 66% are not required to take the computer-delivered language assessment test. They must indicate their condition of disability in the booking form: the CLA reserves the right to assess their knowledge of the language in the ways it considers most appropriate and best suited to the candidate's needs.
- 2. Candidates with disabilities and Specific Learning Difficulties as defined by law no. 170/2010 and Ministerial Decree no. 5669/2011, who require special aids for the carrying out of the test in relation to the type of disability/specific learning difficulty, must notify the Office for students with disabilities and specific learning difficulties. In all cases, candidates will be granted an additional time of 30% of that defined for the test.
 - The Specific Learning Difficulty certificate must refer to the nosographic codes and the explicit wording of the learning difficulty (Reading and/or Writing and/or Calculation).
 - The diagnosis must be updated after 3 years if attested to students when they were minors.
- 3. Students with disabilities or Specific Learning Difficulties **resident abroad**, who wish to benefit from the above-mentioned measures, must present the certification attesting to their disability or Specific Learning Difficulties issued in their country of residence, accompanied by a sworn translation in Italian or English.





4. Requests under points 1, 2 and 3 above must be submitted by the deadline for registration for the language assessment test and will be subject to verification by the Office for students with disabilities and specific learning difficulties, which may request appropriate certification issued by national health service facilities or by specialists and facilities accredited by the latter.

ART. 5.4 – OTHER REQUIREMENTS

- Graduating students carrying out a mobility period may only graduate after the conclusion of the study period abroad and the completion of the digitalised procedure for the recognition of the educational activity envisaged in the Learning Agreement/Change form (exams or thesis research activity), <u>under penalty of returning the grants they received</u> (see Art. 8 Learning Agreement).
- 2. **PhD students** must request the **authorisation** of the PhD coordinator and conclude their stay abroad no later than the end of the legal duration of the PhD programme and obtain a certificate from the host university attesting to the activities carried out.
- 3. **Students in Specialisation Schools** must request the **authorisation** of the Director of the Specialisation School in which they are enrolled to be allowed to carry out their mobility period and **complete** their stay abroad no later than the end of the programme. They must also obtain a certificate from the host university certifying the activity carried out.
- 4. In the case of **specialisation** programmes, the payment of the Erasmus grant is subject to the compatibility of the specialisation contract with the Erasmus grants and is in any case incompatible with the scholarship for deserving students pursuant to L. 398/89. Any incompatibility still allows participation in the programme but without a grant.
- 5. **Non-EU citizens**, in addition to being regularly enrolled at Sapienza, must hold a **residence permit**. In the event of being selected, the possibility of undertaking the exchange is always subject to the issue of an **entry visa** in the country of destination (a procedure that must be followed personally and well in advance of the date of departure). In order to obtain a visa, some countries require students to certify the availability of financial means. The minimum amount varies, but can sometimes exceed the amount of the sum of the mobility grants.
- 6. Students with **double enrolment** may only apply for mobility for their first degree of enrolment

This call is open to students of the Faculty of Economics of the Latina campus and the Rieti campus.

Furthermore, students enrolled in the following inter-faculty courses can apply, exclusively for the disciplines included in the Faculty of Economics' educational offer:

1. CIS – Cooperazione internazionale dello sviluppo;

(bachelor's and master's degrees)

- 2. Scienza della moda e del costume (bachelor's and master's degrees).
- 3. Economia e comunicazione per il management e l'innovazione/ Economics for communication and management innovation (in English) for the areas proposed by the Faculty of Economics (Economics, Business and Statistics) and only for the levels equally indicated (1= bachelor degree; 2= master degree; 3= PhD)

This announcement is <u>not</u> open to students enrolled in other Faculties, except to those enrolled in the Interfaculty Courses specified above.

For those enrolled in a Research Doctorate course, authorization from the Doctorate Coordinator is required

Students who intend to carry out research for their degree thesis <u>must indicate the topic of the research and obtain the approval of the Italian supervisor and the indication of the foreign cosupervisor and obtain the recognition of credits before graduating.</u>

Erasmus+ mobility for study purposes cannot be assigned to graduates carrying out post-graduate professional internships. Students interested in this opportunity will have to apply for the Erasmus+ call for pre- and post-graduate internships (the calls will be published on the page https://www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/erasmustraineeship).

ART. 6 – APPLICATION

ART. 6.1 - DEADLINES AND SUBMISSION METHODS

- 1. The deadline for completing the online application form **is March 5, 2024, at 2 p.m. (Italian time).**
 - The form is available at https://relint.uniroma1.it/candidatura/login.aspx
- 2. For the submission of the application, the use of the institutional e-mail account is mandatory (surname.studentlDnumber@studenti.uniroma1.it).

 The institutional e-mail address will be the only contact used for all communications relating to the Call for applications and subsequent procedures.
- 3. Upon submission of the application, students will receive, at their institutional e-mail address, the report on the data entered as the only attestation that the application has been sent successfully. Each candidate must therefore verify receipt of the report, check the accuracy of the data provided and promptly communicate any compilation/receipt errors to the Faculty Administrative Coordinator for International Mobility Dott.ssa Luana Gallotta, Via del Castro Laurenziano, n° 9, e-mail: exchangestudents-eco@uniroma1.it

ART. 6.2 - SUBMISSION OF THE APPLICATION - LONG MOBILITY

Students may apply for a minimum of no. 1 and a maximum of no. 5 destinations.





- 1. **The order of priority indicated at the time of application is binding** for the purposes of venue allocation, in the event that the candidate is successful for more than one venue
- 2. When choosing the venue, it will be essential to pay attention to:
 - a) **The study opportunities** at international venues by consulting the educational offerings on the websites of the each university;
 - b) **the language level required** to attend classes and take exams (see 'LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS');
 - c) the possibility of taking *CLA* tests for only two languages, in addition to any exemptions (see article "LANGUAGE TEST EXEMPTION").
- 3. In the application form, students must indicate the educational activities they intend to carry out abroad, previously verifying the coherence between the disciplinary field envisaged by the host location and that envisaged in their degree programme. The activities will be indicative and may be refined by preparing the official study plan (see art. 9 "LEARNING AGREEMENT").
- 4. In the case of an application submitted in the transfer between a Bachelor's Degree Programme (first cycle) and a Master's Degree Programme (second cycle), it is necessary to consider the educational activities envisaged in the study plan relating to the Master's Degree Programme.
- 5. **PhD students** and **students in specialisation schools** must check the need for any additional insurance coverage over and above that guaranteed by Sapienza University.
- 6. To successfully complete the application, interested students must complete all fields of the *online* form and ensure that they **have uploaded** the following **documents**, **which constitute an integral part of the application**:
 - Language certificate (only in the case provided for in Article 5.3.1 paragraph 1 letter
 c) "LANGUAGE TEST EXEMPTION")

<u>Failure to upload the compulsory documents, as well as the inaccuracy of the self-certified information, will constitute grounds for exclusion</u>

ART. 6.3 - "SHORT MOBILITY" APPLICATION FOR PhD STUDENTS

- 1. PhD students who plan to apply for the venues available to them and wish to apply for Erasmus+ "SHORT MOBILITY", are required to declare this at the application stage by putting a flag in the appropriate field next to the selected university.
- 2. If the application does not state a willingness to carry out a *short mobility*, the mobility will be considered a *long mobility* and will have to comply with the requirements (see Art. 2 TYPES AND DURATION OF MOBILITY).
- 3. Before starting the mobility, the <u>Erasmus Office of the Faculty</u> must receive formal confirmation of the "Short mobility" from the host university.





ART. 7 - RANKINGS

ART. 7.1 DRAFTING OF THE RANKING LISTS

- A Committee composed of CAM, RAM and RAEF and a student representative and appointed by the Dean of FAculty Faculty - will evaluate the applications. Two rankings will be drawn up:
 - a ranking for the offices of the CIVIS alliance
 - a ranking for the other Erasmus+ destinations.
- 2. The selection will be carried out according to the evaluation criteria that will be formalised by the Committee in the minutes of establishment and will, in any case, be defined in full consistency with the elements to be evaluated.

Evaluation elements for selection purposes will be:

1. Academic merit and in particular:

- Weighted average of the exam scores taken;
- Ratio between the number of credits achieved and the number of credits foreseen by the study plane from the degree course regulations.

The total score obtained by each candidate will be expressed based on **100 total points**, attributed as follows:

- up to 50 points for the weighted average of the exam scores taken;
- up to 50 points for the ratio between the number of credits achieved and the number of credits foreseen by the

study plan and degree course regulations;

• if the score is equal, any additional qualifications in linguistic knowledge will be considered as preferential qualifications when assigning the preferred locations.

NOTE: In the calculation of the weighted average and the CFU acquired will not be considered:

- exams taken abroad during the Erasmus stay for which the validation procedure has not yet been completed;
- extracurricular exams pursuant to art. 6 of RD n. 1269/38 since these tests do not contribute to the

achievement of the ECTS required to obtain the qualification;

- integrated exams and elective teaching activities if the credits relating to all the tests that make up each integrated exam have not been obtained;
- "single course" exams if they have not already been recognized in the bachelor's, single-cycle master's or single-track degree courses in which the student is enrolled for the current academic year;
- exams canceled due to failure to comply with the preparatory requirements;
- exams declared as taken and which are, instead, only booked and not taken or,

even, not booked. In the assignment of mobility, **with equal scores,** priority will be given to students who have never benefited from Erasmus mobility for study reasons, Erasmus placement/ traineeship.

2. Language knowledge:

Language knowledge will be assessed in relation to the documentation provided during the application phase as per art. 2.3.2 and 2.3.3. In the event of equal merit, candidates with superior linguistic knowledge will obtain a higher score.





The result of the test, in addition to being a requirement for access to the tender, could constitute an element of evaluation for the purposes of placement in the ranking.

The test result, as well as being a requirement for access to the call for applications, could be an element of assessment for ranking purposes.

- 3. In the allocation of mobility, **in the case of a tie**, **preference** will be given to students who have never benefited from Erasmus mobility for study purposes, Erasmus placement/traineeship.
- 4. Based on the above criteria, the Committee will draw up a provisional ranking list, which will be published at https://web.uniroma1.it/trasparenza/bando/213622 45/2024
- 5. The ranking shall be considered final if, after 10 natural and consecutive days from the date of publication, no request for revision has been submitted to the Faculty of Economics, Via del Castro Laurenziano, n° 9, 00161, Rome. E-mail address: exchangestudents-eco@uniroma1.it

ART. 7.2 - ACCEPTANCE OF MOBILITY

- 1. Successful candidates must accept the awarded mobility within the following 7 calendar days from the date of publication of the final ranking list or from the date of assignment. <u>Failure to comply with the 7-day deadline will be considered as an ex officio withdrawal</u>.
- 2. Acceptance of the mobility is a serious commitment made by the candidate. Eligible students must therefore limit withdrawals, after acceptance or at the beginning of the mobility period, to serious and proven cases of force majeure, to be communicated in writing and duly justified in order to allow the first reserve candidate to take over in good time.
- 3. **In the event of withdrawal**, the Faculty Erasmus Office will proceed to award the mobility to the next students on the ranking list, who may then be contacted via e-mail and be invited to respond within 2 working days, under penalty of revocation of mobility.

Inclusion in the final rankings will not automatically entail the right to mobility, since the actual award will depend on compliance with the educational constraints/requirements defined by each programme, the faculty and the assigned venue.

ART. 7.3 - FINAL AWARD OF MOBILITY

- 1. Mobility grants are awarded exclusively for the carrying out of educational activities at the partner institution. In order to be eligible for Erasmus grants, the student recipient of mobility grants must, strictly before departure, accept the terms of the <u>financial contract</u> and follow the instructions that will be provided when the mobility grant is awarded.
- 2. For the final award of Erasmus+ mobility the student must have taken care of:
 - a) Completion of the Learning Agreement on the personal Erasmus page and approval by the Academic Coordinator for International Mobility:





Eligibility for mobility is in any case subject to acceptance by the international university, which may request further certification or reject the application on the basis of its own rules not specified in the inter-institutional agreement between Sapienza and the partner university.

ART. 8 – THE LEARNING AGREEMENT

1. Mobility beneficiaries must draw up an official study plan, the so-called Learning Agreement (L.A.), which defines the educational activities to be carried out abroad and which guarantees the recognition of credits (ECTS) obtained by passing exams/theses research abroad.

The drawing up and consequent approval of the L.A. are compulsory and binding for the purposes of taking part in the mobility, under penalty of exclusion from the mobility.

- 2. The L.A. must include exams or educational activities aimed at the attainment and recognition of at least 12 ECTS (not less than 3 ECTS in the case of mobility for thesis research only and not less than 10 ECTS for the qualifying internship).
- 3. In order to be able to draw up the study plan to be carried out at the destination university, students should consult the information available on the web pages of the host institutions before submitting their application. This information will also be binding for the purposes of the mobility assignment.

In order to carry out research for the thesis, PhD or specialisation school, the project must be agreed upon in advance with the Italian supervisor and the Academic Coordinator for International Mobility (*RAM*), in accordance with the agreements established with the professor at the host university.

- 4. At the end of their courses, Erasmus students must sit the exams as laid down by the host university. At the end of the mobility period, the student must obligatorily start the procedure for career recognition of the academic or research activity carried out at the international university. The computerised procedure must be completed exclusively via the personal Erasmus page.
- 5. Recognition of educational activities carried out will take place as indicated by the Faculty and by the "Regulations for Student Mobility and Recognition of Periods of Study and Training Abroad". Exams taken abroad must be recognised in compliance with any propaedeuticity constraints laid down in the regulations for one's degree programme.

ART. 9 - USEFUL INFORMATION

The students must find out for themselves about any **accommodation** opportunities offered by the host universities. They must also find out about:

- **Health care** in the host country by contacting their local health authority or diplomatic representation and consulting the link: http://www.salute.gov.it/;
- How to enter the host country, non-EU citizens should contact the respective diplomatic representations (Embassies and Consulates) in good time. The legislation and regulations governing the entry of non-EU students in the countries participating in the Erasmus+ Programme are related to the nationality of these students: it is the student's responsibility to gather, with the





necessary advance notice, the information and obtain the documents that will allow entry and stay in the country of destination.

The accident and civil liability insurance that the student benefits from automatically upon enrolment at Sapienza is extended, under the same terms, for the entire period spent abroad at the host institution https://www.uniroma1.it/en/pagina/student-insurance.

However, it is recommended to consider taking out additional insurance coverage for travel and medical expenses not covered by the European TEAM card. It is also recommended to register on the MAECI website managed by the Crisis Unit "Dove siamo nel mondo" (https://www.dovesiamonelmondo.it), clearly indicating the required data: names, city/country, university of destination, updated contact details and period of stay.

ART. 10 CHECKS

1. Pursuant to Article 71 of Presidential Decree 445 of December 28, 2000, the Administration will proceed to carry out appropriate checks, also on a sample basis, and in all cases in which grounded doubts arise as to the truthfulness of self-certifications.

Failure to provide truthful information, whether declared or self-certified, constitutes grounds for exclusion/disqualification.

ART. 11 PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

The <u>processing of personal data</u> is governed by Art. 13 of Legislative Decree 196/2003 and Art. 13 and 14 of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 - GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) on the protection of persons and other subjects with regard to the processing of personal data provided, in compliance with the above-mentioned legislation and confidentiality obligations.

ART, 12 PERSON IN CHARGE OF THE PROCEDURE

Pursuant to Law August 7, 1990, no. 241 and subsequent amendments and additions, for the scope of the exclusive competence of Sapienza University of Rome, Faculty of Economics the person in charge of the procedure is the Administrative Coordinator for International Mobility Dr., Luana Gallotta - e-mail: exchangestudents-eco@uniroma1.it time and place of receipt: – Via del Castro Laurenziano n. 9, Rome (reception by appointment).

ART. 13 END OF THE PROCEDURE

The deadline within which the results of the selection procedure are supposed to be finalised and published is the end of April 2024.

In case of interpretative conflicts between the two versions (ITA and EN), the Italian text will prevail.

This call for applications is published in English and Italian. In the event of conflicting interpretations between the two versions (ITA and EN), the only applicable text is the Italian version.

Annexe 1: ORGANISATION OF LANGUAGE TESTS AT THE SAPIENZA'S LANGUAGE CENTRE (*CLA*)

Students who will be admitted to the selection on the basis of the language test taken at the CLA must in any case be in possession of the level of language proficiency required by the host institution, otherwise, they will not be eligible for mobility.

It will only be possible to take **one test** for each language **up to a maximum of two languages**.

There will be no make-up sessions. For those who have already taken tests in the September, November and December 2023 sessions, it will not be possible to retake the test(s).

- 1. The tests for **FRENCH**, **ENGLISH**, **PORTUGUESE**, **SPANISH**, **and GERMAN** language will be carried out at *CLA*, in person: the student must present a valid identification document (identity card, passport, driving licence).
- 2. Students who have not already taken the test in the sessions from September to November 2023 must book their place by choosing the date and time from the options available in the application form, according to the calendar available at the link https://web.uniroma1.it/cla/faq-test-linguistici-cla-mobilita-internazionale
- 3. Booking for the tests is only confirmed upon receipt of the notification e-mail in the institutional mailbox.
- 4. The language level tests are of the multistage type (with a pass threshold) and include questions:
 - multiple-choice
 - cloze response
 - drag and drop on text
- 5. The tests focus mainly on grammar knowledge and text comprehension. **Speaking and listening are not included**.

The test starts at level A2 and, depending on your score, you can move on to the next levels (step by step) up to level C1. The test will last a maximum of approximately 60 minutes (if all four levels are completed).

Online test simulations are not available.

It is recommended that you book your test(s) in good time, in order to have the widest possible choice on the days still available.

The test results will be published on Moodle but will only be transmitted to the application if the student opens the form by going to this link: https://relint.uniroma1.it/candidatura/login.aspx

The test results will be visible in the application as follows:

- January 2024 within January 31, 2024
- February 2024 within February 26, 2024





However, students who have already taken the test at *CLA* from September to November 2023 are invited to access the <u>application form</u> to enable them to obtain their test results by <u>February 26, 2024.</u>

The certificate concerning the result obtained in the language test will only be issued to Erasmus mobility participants. This certificate, which is NOT a language certificate by law, can be downloaded directly from one's own personal Erasmus page.

On the day of the test, the student must present him/herself PUNCUALLY at the CLA laboratories located in the Marco Polo Building on floor 0, Circonvallazione Tiburtina 4 (formerly Scalo S. Lorenzo, 82).
