DECREES

ART. 1 – Subject of the competition and amount of the scholarships

It is announced a competition based on exams and qualifications for candidates holding a Master's Degree or a single cycle Master's Degree, completed at Sapienza University of Rome for the allocation of 400 monthly instalments for scholarships to attend specialisation programmes or activities at international Universities outside Italy, or excluded the candidate's native country in the event of non-Italian applicants to the call. The duration of the scholarship is from six to twelve months, for a monthly amount of \in 1,290.00.



ART. 2 – Allocation of the Scholarships Each CUN disciplinary area is assigned a number of months according to the following table:

ART. 3 – Admission Requirements

To participate in the call, candidates must have the following requirements under penalty of exclusion:

- a) a Master's Degree or a single cycle Master's Degree or equivalent to the same degree class, required for the corresponding disciplinary area and obtained at Sapienza University of Rome within the last degree session of the academic year 2022-2023
- b) age no older than twenty-nine at the date of publication of the call (this is to be intended that that after the midnight of the twenty-ninth birthday, the candidate is considered not eligible due to age limit). It is excluded any modification in the age limit provided for by the regulations in force;
- c) knowledge of the language required by the host institution;
- d) possession of formal documentation provided by the international University chosen by the candidate, as per the following art. 5. In the event the acceptance shall not be confirmed the candidate will be excluded from the competition due to the lack of one of the admission requirements.

The programme and the activities shall be strictly relevant to the disciplinary area they refer to and to the candidate's past academic career.

ART. 4 – Incompatibility

The scholarship is **not compatible** with the following situations:

- a) previous benefit from scholarships for specialisation programmes and activities abroad
- b) enrolment without any scholarship in PhDs, Specialisation Schools or Advanced Professional Courses in Italian universities: the winners of this competition shall either obtain the suspension of their attendance to the programme before leaving or waive the enrolment. Such suspension or waiver shall be communicated to <u>dirittoallostudio@uniroma1.it</u>
- c) enrolment, with a scholarship awarded by Sapienza or other Italian universities, for PhDs, Specialisation Schools or Advanced Professional Courses: the winners of this competition must waive the enrolment in the programmes before their departure
- d) ownership of any other scholarship awarded at any title, as at the start date of the postgraduate scholarship. Exception made for scholarships awarded by Italian or international institutions which are useful to integrate the training and research activity of scholarship holders with periods spent abroad, including any scholarship provided, by the host institution where will be conducted the activities
- e) gross overall personal income higher than € 7,750.00 with reference to the solar year of use of the scholarship. The personal income is defined by property income and by any kind of regular emoluments, except those occasional.

Any incompatibility must be corrected before the departure, under penalty of forfeiture of both the scholarship and the benefits obtained, as well as the obligation to return any amount received.

Public employees who benefit from the scholarship of this call may also apply for an extraordinary leave for study reasons without grants, provided for candidates admitted to PhD courses by article 2 of Law of August 13, 1984, no. 476. The period of extraordinary leave can be calculated for career progression as well as for retirement and social security contributions.



ART. 5 – Application and Deadlines

Candidates can apply once for one CUN area to which their degree corresponds (see Tab 1)

In the event that the candidates' degree class corresponds to more than one CUN disciplinary area, they shall still choose only one CUN disciplinary area, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

Applications must be submitted by July 18, 2024, under penalty of exclusion.

The application, drafted according to the form attached to the call for applications (Attachment A), must be sent **in pdf format** to **protocollosapienza@cert.uniroma1.it exclusively via the** <u>candidates' personal</u> and **certified email (PEC)**. Submission from institutional certified email addresses to public or private companies, public bodies, relatives, third parties, etc, will not be accepted.

Applications submitted to Sapienza in different modalities other than the abovementioned will not be accepted.

Transmission and reception validity of the certified email is certified by the acceptance and delivery receipt sent by the email provider pursuant to art. 6 of Presidential Decree of February 11, 2005, no. 68.

The subject of the certified email must be: "CONCORSO PERFEZIONAMENTO ESTERO 2024 – AREA DISCIPLINARE CUN(Insert CUN Area) – Candidate Name and Surname – Students ID Number

Besides Attachment A, candidates must also attach to the application the following documents in pdf format, under penalty of exclusion:

1. formal documentation provided by the international University chosen by the candidate, (or a statement on headed paper of a professor from the same institution), stating the candidate's acceptance, or intention to accept, to the programme or the specialisation activity.

The formal documentation shall state:

- a) in case of a study programme, its name, duration and study plan
- b) in case of a specialisation activity, one of its programmes;
- 2. a self-certification of the candidate's qualifications and publications, contents descriptions, an abstract and all details of the journal and the ISBN, ISMN, ISSN or DOI codes drafted according to the **Attachment B**

The documents in the previous points 1 and 2 shall be translated into Italian if originally in a language other than English.

All candidates are conditionally admitted, until verification of their requirements, and may be excluded any time by means of a grounded measure.

The Administration reserves the right to verify the truthfulness of self-certifications and to take forfeiture measures against any candidates who have made untrue declarations. They will therefore forfeit any benefit obtained due to submission of untrue documentation,



and shall return all the sums received, if any, without prejudice of the provisions of art. 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000 and of articles 483, 485 and 486 of the Penal Code.

ART. 6 – Competition Procedures

The competition will be assessed on the bases of candidate's qualifications and exams which will be at Sapienza University of Rome.

To assess the candidates' qualifications and exams, an Examination Committee will be appointed by the Rector for each disciplinary area, composed of three/five professors, among which at least one Full Professor to chair the Committee.

Each Committee can assign maximum 100 points to the candidates, as follows:

Publications up to 5 points:

- up to 2 points per each publication *in extenso* on journals, books, international volumes;
- up to 1 point per each publication in extenso on journals, books, national volumes;
- up to 0.5 points per each abstract of "speeches" in congresses/conferences.

Other qualifications up to 15 points:

- 5 points per each PhD or Specialisation Course;
- 2 points per each specialisation programme, Advanced Professional Course or *post-lauream* scholarship for masters graduates awarded by universities or public/private bodies of at least six-month duration.

The Committee may request candidates to show the self-declared qualifications and publications during the qualification assessment or interview.

The remaining 50 points will be assigned upon interview.

The Examination Committee, after ascertaining the qualification of the international academic institution located abroad, as well as the suitability of the submitted course and programme with the candidate's previous academic career and chosen disciplinary area, will communicate the date of interview to the suitable candidates.

The list of candidates admitted to the interview will be published in the *Albo Pretorio Concorsi* section at <u>web.uniroma1.it/trasparenza/bandi_trasparenza</u> as well as at <u>www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/borse-di-perfezionamento-allestero</u> and communicated to the certified email address used by candidates to send their application.

The interview will be aimed at ascertaining the candidates' inclination and background in the disciplinary area of choice required to attend the courses/activities of the international academic institution, as well as their proper knowledge of the required language. Candidates must show a valid ID during the interview.

To pass the interview candidates must obtain a minimum of 35 points.



Art. 7 – Publication of the provisional and final ranking list

The decision of the Examination Committee is final.

On the basis of the points obtained by each candidate, the Committee will draft a general ranking of qualified candidates according to which it will assign the monthly scholarship, until availability of places.

The provisional rankings will be published within three months after the deadline of the call for applications, considering the suspensions of the educational activity provided for academic calendar. in the Albo Pretorio Concorsi section bv the at web.uniroma1.it/trasparenza/bandi trasparenza well as as at www.uniroma1.it/it/pagina/borse-di-perfezionamento-allestero.

No scholarships shorter than six months can be awarded.

In case of waiver or forfeiture of the assigns, another eligible candidate will succeed, within the solar year following the publication of this call for applications, according to the ranking decreasing order and until availability of places. In the event of remaining amounts due to of lack of suitable candidates, these will become resources for the University financial status.

The provisional ranking shall become final if no request for its revision is submitted after 5 (five) natural and consecutive days from the date of publication.

The Right to Education Unit - grants and benefits publishes a special notice stating that the provisional ranking list has become final. In the event of requests for revision, the Right to Education Unit - grants and benefits publishes a notice specifying the date by which the final ranking list will be published.

Art. 8 Request to rectify the provisional ranking list

Against the provisional ranking list, the student who has participated in the competition may submit, through certified e-mail address used to send the application for participation in the competition procedure, a request for correction of errors and/or omissions, which must be delivered to the Right to Education Unit - grants and benefits that has issued the call for applications no later than 5 (five) natural and consecutive days from the publication of the provisional ranking list.

A request for rectification received after the aforementioned deadline is null and void. The request must clearly and punctually state the reasons for the request to rectify the ranking list.

As a general rule, the Selection Board shall examine the substance of the request within 5 (five) natural and consecutive days of its submission. If the application is accepted, a notice shall be drawn up and published with the new ranking list, which shall be final. No further appeals are envisaged.

In the event that more than 5 days are necessary for the evaluation of the requests received, a special notice will be published on the institutional website with details of the publication of the final ranking list.

The publication of the final ranking list constitutes, for all purposes, notification to the interested parties of the outcome of the rectification request.

ART. 9 – Payment of the Scholarship

The payment of scholarship will be made in two instalments:

- the first instalment, equal to 2/3 of the scholarship's amount, at beginning of the activity

- the second instalment, equal to 1/3 of the scholarship's amount, at the end of the activity.



a) Acceptance of the Scholarship and Payment of the First Instalment

After publication of the ranking, the candidates ranked in suitable positions are required by the competent office to confirm their acceptance via the same certified email address of the application **within 30 days** and under penalty of forfeiture. To accept, they must include in the email:

- 1. a self-declaration that they have never benefited from any scholarships for thirdcycle programmes abroad as well as their commitment not to benefit, for the entire duration of this scholarship, from any other scholarships awarded at any title
- 2. a self-declaration that their gross overall personal income, with reference to the solar year of entitlement of scholarship, will not exceed € 7,750.00
- 3. self-declaration that they are not enrolled, at the start of the third-cycle programme or postgraduate activity abroad, in any specialisation school, advanced professional course, PhD or, if they do not hold any scholarship, that they are committed to suspend their attendance
- 4. the formal documentation issued by the foreign or international academic institution located abroad or a declaration, on letterhead, of a professor of the institution candidates will attend stating the actual start date and duration of the programme or the specialisation activity (start and end day/month/year), to make the scholarship effective

b) Payment of the Second Instalment

For the payment of the second instalment, at the end of their stay abroad, the winner must send to <u>dirittoallostudio@uniroma1.it</u>.a certificate issued by the international institution stating the start and end dates of their attendance to the programme or activity.

Payment of scholarship is subject to the actual duration of the third-cycle programme or postgraduate activity abroad.

Fractions higher than fifteen days will be considered equal to a month, for payment purposes.

The self-certifications submitted will be verified pursuant to the regulations in force.

ART. 10 – Procedures for the Entitlement of Scholarships

Scholarships are not retroactive and can be paid starting from the day after successfully passing the interview for a minimum duration of six months. The beginning of the relevant activity is allowed within the solar year following that of publication of the call.

The entitlement of a scholarship must be sequential, cannot be divisible and does not entail a work relationship, as it is aimed at the cultural education of scholarship holders; a scholarship does not provide either any social security contributions or any assessment for juridical or economics careers and is exempt from personal income tax.

Winners will have to subscribe at their own expense any insurance policy required by the international institution.

Throughout their attendance, scholarship holders shall maintain the requisites as per art. 3 above and avoid the incompatibilities as per art 4. Failure of the prescribed requisites will entail the forfeiture of the scholarship and the obligation for the concerned party to promptly inform Sapienza and reimburse, partially or in full, the sums already received.

Winners shall attend the programmes abroad or specialisation activities without interruptions in the institutions chosen. Scholarship holders cannot be involved in educational activities under any circumstance.



In the event scholarship holders should not complete the six-month minimum period of stay abroad, they shall return in full the sums received and therefore will not be paid the second instalment.

ART. 11 – Postponement of the Start Sate

Any postponements of the scholarship's start date or discontinuance of its entitlement will be allowed to winners falling under conditions provided for by Legislative Decree of March 26, 2001, no. 151 and further amendments and integrations (maternity and *puerperium*), provided that the foreign institution which the scholarship holder is assigned to issues a formal authorisation to postpone the start date or discontinue attendance; such document as well shall be officially translated into Italian.

Candidates who are under said conditions as at the date of reception of the letter for scholarship award shall submit a declaration issued pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, indicating the periods of mandatory leave pursuant to Legislative Decree of March 26, 2001, no. 151 and further amendments and integrations (maternity and *puerperium*).

ART.12 - Person in Charge of Administrative Procedures
