**CALL FOR SETTING UP A RANKING OF INCOMING SRUDENTS OF 1ST, 2ND AND 3RD CYCLE FROM
ARGENTINIAN INSTITUTIONS ASSOCIATED TO THE ITALIAN PARTNERS OF THIS PROJECT**

GIVEN THAT

- on October 3, 2023, the Ministry of University and Research (hereinafter “MUR”), Directorate General for Internationalization and Communication, issued Director’s Decree No. 0167 regarding the “Notice for the granting of funding for transnational educational initiatives” (hereinafter “Notice”);
- the Notice defined the “specific guidelines for the selection and funding of at least 10 transnational educational initiatives (TNE), as set forth in sub-measure T4 “Transnational Initiatives in Education”, Investment 3.4 “University Education and Advanced Skills” of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan, Mission 4 “Education and Research” – Component 1 “Strengthening the education service offering: from nursery schools to universities”;
- intending to participate, the Italian Interuniversity Consortium for Argentina (CUIA) developed a project proposal entitled “ProMOTing innoVation capacity IN the hiGher Education System of Argentina and ITaly through an Action scheme for the MobiLlty And cooperation of UNiversity StudeNts and ProfESSorS – MOVING ITALIANNESS” (hereinafter “Project Proposal”) jointly with the following associated institutions actively participating in the project:

and submitted it to the MUR on November 28, 2023 (TNE23-00080);

ACKNOWLEDGING THAT

- with Director's Decree (D.D.) no. 188 of 26 June 2024, the MUR approved the provisional ranking list of eligible and fundable projects under the funds referred to in D.D. prot. no. 167 of 03 October 2023;
- on 12 July 2024, the CUIA, in its capacity as lead partner, transmitted to the MUR Directorate General for Internationalization and Communication the rescheduling of the project and cost plan following the redefinition of the assigned funding;
- with Director's Decree no. 255 of 25 July 2024, the MUR approved the final ranking list of eligible projects to be financed after the rescheduling of the budget under the funds referred to in D.D. prot. No. 167 of 03 October 2023;
- the Project Proposal MOVING ITALIANNESS, with a score of 18 points, was deemed eligible and to be funded for the amount of euro 1,988,761.28 (hereinafter "Project");
- the MUR acknowledged the possibility for the CUIA, as lead entity, to sign agreements with foreign institutions that expressed their interest in participating in the Project, also in the name and on behalf of the associated Italian universities and project partners;
- the President of the CUIA signed the Deed of Obligation with the MUR;
- the amount of euro 323,783.71 was allocated to Sapienza by Director's Decree no. 255 of 25 July 2024, subsequently rescheduled in favour of Sapienza for a total amount of €324,262.11;
- with resolution no. 282/2024 of 24 September 2024, the Administration Board of Sapienza has decided that, considering the specific nature of the expenses included in the project budget, the funds will be transferred to the Departments of affiliation of the respective scientific coordinators;
- the scientific coordinator of the project for Sapienza is Prof. De Sio from the Department of Anatomical Histological Medical Legal Sciences and Locomotor Apparatus
- the following departments expressed interest in establishing new relationships and consolidating and strengthening existing international partnerships with Argentina: the Department of Architecture and Project, the Department of Methods and Models for Economics, Territory and Finance, the Department of Public Health and Infectious Diseases, the Department of Anatomical Histological Medical Legal Sciences and Locomotor Apparatus, the Department of Political Sciences, the Department of Statistical Sciences, and the Department of History, Drawing and Restoration of Architecture, whose specific call for applications has already been published with Rector's Decree no. 1104/2025, prot. no. 0051888 of 07 April 2025, to allow its competent academic staff to carry out their mobilities according to a previously agreed schedule with the Argentinian partners;

- with Director's Order no. 2703/2025 of 17 June 2025, the budget variation has been authorized for a total amount of euro 324,262.11 under the revenue account A.R.04.03.010.010 "Contracts/agreements/program agreements with the MUR" – project 282572_C_TNE_PNRR_CUIA – UA.S.001.DRD.ARDIS.OTM;

THE RECTOR DECREES

ART. 1 – SUBJECT

As part of the "TNE-MOVING ITALIANESS" project, coordinated by the CUIA, a selection procedure is hereby announced for the award of financial grants, within the limits of the project's available funding. These grants are reserved to a total of thirteen (13) students - specifically, five (5) 1st, 2nd or 3rd cycle students from the Faculty of Architecture, Design, and Urbanism (FADU) of the University of Buenos Aires (UBA), Argentina, **for short-term mobilities** (1 month), and further eight (8) students within the double degree in Architecture between the Faculty of Architecture at Sapienza University of Rome and the Faculty of Architecture and Urbanism (FAU) of the Universidad Nacional del Nordeste (UNNE), Argentina, **for long-term mobilities** (4 months).

For the short-term mobility open positions, any possible ranking scroll beyond the five (5) available grants may occur, should additional funds become available and their use be approved by the MUR. For the long-term mobility open positions Students who are already at the host university are also eligible to participate in this selection process.

ART. 2 – OBJECTIVES AND ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES

The project aims both at establishing new relationships and at strengthening and consolidating existing international partnerships with Argentina. Accordingly, the general objective of this call for applications is to enable Argentinian students to undertake a period abroad for study, training, research, or internship at Sapienza University of Rome. In details:

- the five (5) students from FADU - UBA will participate in the second International seminar that will take place at the Department of History, Drawing, and Restoration of Architecture of the Faculty of Architecture of Sapienza University of Rome in October 2025, subsequent to the first International seminar, that took place at UBA in Buenos Aires in May 2025 and that is dedicated to "Heritage Building Information Modelling and Architectural Heritage";

- the eight (8) students from FAU - UNNE regularly enrolled at the double degree in Architecture between the Faculty of Architecture at Sapienza University of Rome and the FAU – UNNE will attend a whole semester (4 months) at Sapienza, and make exams for a total amount of 30 ECTS, as established by the double degree agreement.

ART. 3 – BENEFICIARIES AND BASIC REQUIREMENTS

Eligible to participate in this selection notice are:

- **Short-term mobilities** – five (5) students enrolled in a 1st, 2nd or 3rd cycle study programme of the FADU - UBA, who attended full-time the first “Heritage Building Information Modelling and Architectural Heritage” International seminar, hold at FADU - UBA in May 2025. Basic requirements are as follows:
 - To be Architecture students regularly enrolled at FADU - UBA
 - Preferably with knowledge of 3D modelling and HBIM procedures
 - Preferably with Italian and/or English language knowledge;
- **Long-term mobilities** - eight (8) students enrolled in the double degree in Architecture between the Faculty of Architecture at Sapienza University of Rome and the FAU – UNNE. Basic requirement is to be regularly enrolled at the double degree in Architecture between Sapienza University of Rome and FAU – UNNE.

To ensure that disability does not hinder the possibility of successfully undertaking a mobility period abroad, each home university assists its students in identifying tools, aids, and services that can help them fully experience mobility under the “TNE-MOVING ITALIANNESS” project. The host university, namely Sapienza, will provide support throughout the mobility experience for students with disabilities. Yet, it is important that disadvantaged students inquire in advance, prior to the call deadline, about the availability of adequate support services in Sapienza.

ART. 4 – MOBILITY PERIOD AND DURATION

All activities eligible for funding must be completed by March 31, 2026.

All expenses related to the mobility must be incurred and reported by this date; failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the grant.

The maximum duration of mobility periods funded under the project is 30 days for short-term mobilities and 4 months for long-term mobilities. In any case, the mobility must have a minimum duration of 15 days, during which any study or traineeship activity must be carried out.

Up to two travel days may be recognized in addition to the duration of the mobility, regardless of the total number of travel days actually taken.

During the mobility period, students are not permitted to graduate or obtain the qualification for which they are enrolled at their home institution, nor are they allowed to transfer to another university.

Should a student, after having commenced the mobility period, need to extend the stay in order to complete or supplement the activities set forth in the Learning Agreement, an extension may be requested.

Authorization for the extension will be granted only after obtaining approval from the host institution. The total mobility period, including the extension, may not exceed four (4) months and must not extend beyond March 31, 2026.

Any withdrawal, for any reason, from the assigned mobility must be promptly communicated via email to the address associated with the project of the department for which the candidate applied and was selected. In the event of withdrawal, the competent offices will contact the next eligible candidate on the ranking list.

ART. 5 – USEFUL INFORMATION FOR MOBILITY

Students must ensure that their passport is valid for the entire duration of the mobility period. Furthermore, they must gather in due time all relevant information and obtain the necessary documentation required for entry and stay in Italy.

The administrative office of the Department of History, Drawing, and Restoration of Architecture at Sapienza University of Rome will remain available to provide supporting documentation for students applying for entry visas and/or insurance policies. However, all associated costs and the management of such procedures are the sole responsibility of the student. The possibility of undertaking the exchange is always subject to the issuance of the entry visa, which must be personally arranged by the student well in advance of the intended departure date.

For the entire period, incoming students are automatically covered by accident and third-party liability insurance provided by Sapienza University of Rome.

For short mobility periods in Italy, it is strongly recommended that students obtain private health insurance coverage through an insurance provider, while it is also possible to register to the National Health System for longer periods of stay.

ART. 6 - APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND DEADLINES

The application for participation, along with any documents deemed relevant for the selection process, must be submitted by **July 17, 2025**.

Each candidate's mobility proposal must specify both a departure date and a return date, being aware that all activities must be completed no later than March 31, 2026.

The application must be completed in all its parts, following the application form template attached to this call (Annex 1 and Annex 2), and must include all required information, such as: the home institution details, the mobility purpose, and its duration.

All questions regarding this call and the procedures for completing the application may also be sent to the same email address.

ART. 7 - APPLICATION EVALUATION PROCEDURES

The Selection Committee shall be composed of two academic staff members and one administrative staff member, selected from among the personnel affiliated with the Department of History, Drawing, and Restoration of Architecture. The Committee shall be responsible for evaluating the applications received at the address specified in the table under Article 6. The evaluation results, in the form of official minutes, must be signed and submitted to the email address of the RUP (Person/Officer Responsible for the Procedure), as specified under Article 11, for the preparation of the final ranking. The Committee shall draw up a merit ranking of eligible candidates based on the following criteria and corresponding scores, depending on the type of mobility proposed by the applicants.

For short-term mobilities, the evaluation will be based on the following criteria and maximum scores:

- a) Full-time attendance of the International seminar held in Buenos Aires in May 2025 (50 points);
- b) Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum (40 points);
- c) Knowledge of the language of the host country and/or another working language (10 points).

For long-term mobilities, the evaluation will be based on the following criteria and maximum scores:

- a) Regular enrolment at the double
- b) degree in Architecture between Sapienza University of Rome and FAU - UNNE (50 points);
- b) Curriculum Vitae et Studiorum and Grade Point Average (40 points);
- c) Knowledge of the language of the host country and/or another working language (10 points).

In both cases, applications receiving a total score of less than 40 points shall not be eligible for funding.

Selected students are reminded that it is their responsibility to promptly obtain information about the administrative requirements and deadlines imposed by the host institutions, failing which there is a risk of not being accepted by the latter.

Within five (5) days of receiving the notification, successful applicants must accept or decline the offer by replying to the email received; failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the grant.

The final ranking list of selected incoming students will be made public by Rectoral Decree through publication on the University's website.

WARNING: It is the responsibility of the selected candidates to correctly complete all required procedures and comply with the deadlines indicated in this call for applications. Failure to do so will result in the loss of authorization to carry out the mobility in Sapienza University of Rome and the associated financial support.

ART. 8 - FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR MOBILITY

Successful students at the end of the selection procedures will receive a mobility contribution. These contributions are not intended to cover the full cost of studying abroad, but serve solely as partial support for the expenses incurred by the student. The grant is not cumulative with other mobility-related financial aid.

Subject to the ranking order and within the limits of available financial resources, the contributions will be allocated to the selected students according to the following scheme:

TRAVEL	DAILY ALLOWANCE
Up to euro 2,000.00 (round trip)	Up to euro 1.000,00 per month

The monthly amount will be awarded for the indicative number of months corresponding to the accepted duration of the mobility period, while short-term mobilities lasting less than 1 month will be awarded for the actual number of days of their duration dividing the monthly allowance per 30 and multiplying the outcome per number of days of mobility (example: 15 days of mobility is equal to 1.000,00 euro : 30 days x 15 days).

The University will cover the costs of round-trip travel from the main international airports in Argentina to Rome.

The financial contribution will be disbursed as reimbursement of travel expenses. If the actual period abroad is shorter than the period specified in the contract, the total amount of the contribution will be recalculated based on the actual duration of the mobility.

It is specified that the reimbursement will be made to a bank account held by the beneficiary, only after completion of financial verification and the related banking procedures.

Payment deadlines are subject to the internal accounting timelines of Sapienza. Delays may occur during summer closure periods and at the end of the fiscal year.

Reimbursement will not be granted in the following cases:

- Mobility period is shorter than the minimum mandatory duration in-person, according to the type of mobility;

- Withdrawal from studies, university transfer, or change of degree programme between the submission of the application and the conclusion of the mobility period;
- Graduation from the degree programme between the submission of the application and the conclusion of the mobility period.

ART. 9 – RECOGNITION

At the end of the mobility period, the home universities guarantee full recognition of the academic activities completed abroad and certified by the host university through the Transcript of Records (TOR). Recognition of study periods will be carried out following each university's internal regulations. Within 15 days following the conclusion of the mobility period, the mobility beneficiary shall submit the following documents to the designated contact person of the relevant department, as specified in Article 6:

- the certificate of participation issued by Sapienza at the end of the mobility period, duly signed, certifying the exact period of stay at the host institution (dd/mm/yyyy of arrival – dd/mm/yyyy of departure);
- a report on the activities undertaken during the mobility, in accordance with the provisions of the Mobility Agreement;
- a copy of the documentation related to the expenses incurred.

Each department, upon completion of the mobility period of its respective grant beneficiaries, shall carry out financial reporting in accordance with point 5 of the Guidelines for Financial Reporting for Implementing Entities of the PNRR Italia Initiatives, issued by the Ministry of University and Research as the managing authority – Procedures for Reporting the Progress of Activities and Expenditures (summary in Annex 3).

ART. 10 – PRIVACY

The personal data contained in the application will be processed for the purposes of managing the present procedure and in compliance with the current legislation on personal data processing (Annex 2).

The data will be processed - by authorized personnel - using manual, electronic, and telematic tools, within the scope and for the purposes indicated above, in accordance with the security measures adopted by the Universities and in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation No. 2016/679 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and the free movement of such data, as well as with national legislative decrees adapting domestic law to the aforementioned Regulation.

Candidates may exercise the rights provided for in Sections 2, 3, and 4 of Chapter III of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (e.g., rights to information and access, rectification and erasure, restriction and objection to processing, and data portability).

ART. 11 - OFFICER RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE PROCEDURE

ART. 12 – PUBLICATION

This call for applications will be published on the Official Website of the University, where also the Selection Committee, the eligibility ranking list, and the final ranking list of students selected for mobility will also be made available.

Purpose and Legal Basis of Processing

The processing of the requested personal data is aimed at managing the selection procedure for the allocation of grants under the TNE PNRR Moving Italianness initiative, addressed to incoming students from Argentinian partner institutions to Sapienza. Pursuant to Article 6 of the Regulation, the processing of personal data is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the data controller.

Nature of Data Provision and Consequences of Refusal

Providing personal data through the application form for the TNE PNRR Moving Italianness selection call, addressed to incoming students from Argentinian partner institutions to Sapienza, is mandatory for identifying candidates, assessing applications, drafting the relevant ranking list, and allocating financial contributions.

Processing Methods and Authorized Personnel

Personal data will be processed by designated staff members from the single relevant departments of Sapienza University of Rome involved in the TNE PNRR Moving Italianness initiative, and by the members of the Selection Committee. Data will be processed exclusively and only for the time necessary to carry out the selection procedures, compile the relevant ranking list, and allocate financial contributions, including the handling of any related disputes.

There are no additional recipients of the data, and the data will not, under any circumstances, be processed for the purpose of sending advertising material, direct sales, market research, or commercial communications.

Data Subject Rights

The data subject is informed that, under the applicable conditions, they may request from the data controller or the data protection officer (as indicated above) access to their personal data pursuant to Article 15 of the Regulation, rectification under Article 16, erasure under Article 17, or restriction of processing under Article 18. The data subject may also object to the processing under Article 21 or exercise the right to data portability under Article 20.
