Graduated in Law and holding a PhD in Political Languages and Communication, she achieved a particular aptitude for multidisciplinary and orienting knowledge towards societal challenges. She has multifaceted training with a good expertise in applied social research (both through quantitative and qualitative methods). Her graduate studies have been gender-based, while her PhD aimed at defining the commons on the occasion of the Italian referendum against the privatization of the national water service. Post-doctoral research experiences, on the other hand, have mainly focused on the media practices of different social sectors: namely, grassroots organizations, indigenous communities, schools, women's movements, older people and youths. That is, she has approached to several issues, such as gender equality, media democratization, teen civic engagement, and ageist stereotypes, which do gather all her interests as a scholar, journalist and activist. She has participated in multidisciplinary and international research projects, and worked in Spain, Ecuador, Bolivia and Argentina both as Visiting and Postdoctoral Fellow. Her latest papers have been published on high-impact journals and presented in international conferences.

Postdoctoral Fellowship at LUMSA University of Rome. The research addresses the problem of teen dating violence by matching gender issues with ICT-related behaviors and perceptions. More specifically, it aims at exploring whether and how Italian young people perceive violent behaviors within intimate relationships which unfold through/in social media ("digital abuse" or "cyber dating abuse").

Simultaneously, research (survey) and interventions (training and filming activities) have been co-conducted with secondary school students in order to investigate and develop adolescents' protective factors against dating violence and to promote healthy love relationships. The activities carried out in Rome are part of the European project "[Lights4Violence](#)" (funded by the European Commission Directorate-General Justice and Consumers Rights, Equality and Citizen Violence Against Women Programme 2016, under grant agreement No. 776905). The partnership involves: Universidad de Alicante (Spain); LUMSA University of Rome (Italy); Universitatea de Medicina si Farmacie Grigore T.Popa Iasi (Romania); Cardiff Metropolitan University (UK); Adam Mickiewicz University (Poland); Instituto de Salud Carlos III (Spain); and Maieutica Cooperativa de Ensino Superior Crl (Portugal). The social media management of the European project has been carried out throughout the duration of the contract as well.
