Fabio Sabatini is Associate Professor of Economics at Sapienza University of Rome, Department of Economics and Law, where he also serves as Chair of the European PhD Programme in Socio-Economic and Statistical Studies.

He is Research Fellow at IZA - Institute of Labor Economics in Bonn and Research Associate at the Higher School of Economics in Moscow.

He obtained the Italian national scientific qualification (abilitazione scientifica nazionale) as Full Professor (professore ordinario) of Political Economy (sector 13/A1), Economic Policy (13/A2), Public Economics (13/A3) and Applied Economics (13/A4).

He currently is a top 5% author in the RePEc worldwide ranking of economists in terms of 7 of the 33 RePEc criteria.

His H-Index is **28** as of April 2020 (**3020** citations according to Scholar).

He published: **21** papers in A-journals for the competition sector 13/A1 (*Economia Politica*) and **24** papers in A-journals for the broader area of economics (*Area 13*).

I am currently pursuing three main lines of research.</p> <p>The first investigates the role of ICTs infrastructures – such as broadband, mobile phone networks, and social networking sites – in societal and political change, and the economic outcomes of these transformations. To this purpose, my recent empirical work entails the use of big data.</p> <p>The second line of research explores the determinants and the economic outcomes of social capital (mainly in the forms of networks and trust), with a special focus on the exogenous sources of variation of social capital.</p> <p>The third line of research investigates how policy measures and exogenous shocks affect social preferences, with a particular focus on support for redistributive policies.</p> <p>More in general, my motivation as a researcher is to discover structures in society and understand people’s motivation for doing things – be it in markets or any other realm of human behavior. For this reason, my research areas are vast and interdisciplinary.</p>


