Mesopotamia	My research to date has focused on the study of Sumerian society, particularly on the characterization of Sumerian identities, symbolism, cultural traditions, and processes of cultural change across time and space, especially during the 3rd millennium BC. To investigate these themes, I analyze the archaeological record in conjunction with iconographic data, while considering contemporary cuneiform sources. I have extensive expertise in field archaeology in the Near East, as well as in the analysis of the archaeological record and iconographic studies. The study of Sumerian art, iconography, and iconology has been my primary research focus until I began fieldwork in Iraq. This not only provided a complex framework for interpreting and understanding the archaeological record but also deepened my knowledge of Sumerian social and cultural traditions. I serve as co-director, alongside Franco D’Agostino, of the Iraqi-Italian Mission at Abu Tbeirah (Nasiriyah, Dhi-Qar Governorate), which commenced shortly after the end of the Saddam regime and the withdrawal of foreign forces, despite the initially complex local situation. The work at Abu Tbeirah built on my experience (2004-2010) with the Ebla Mission in Syria, where I was responsible for archaeological areas E and F, as well as for managing post-excavation activities. Since the inception of the Abu Tbeirah Mission, I have been responsible for logistics in Iraq, field direction, post-excavation data management, and coordination of our interdisciplinary team, which is involved in scientific and technological analyses of Abu Tbeirah's materials. I have also played an active role in fundraising, drafting project proposals, and managing the administration and reporting aspects of the project. With the support of the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs, I have participated in the training of personnel from the Iraqi State Board of Antiquities and Heritage (SBAH) in Nasiriyah, and in developing the maintenance plan for the archaeological park at Ur. My current research also explores the environmental aspects connected to the development of Sumerian culture during the 3rd millennium BC, with particular attention to geoarchaeology and the human exploitation of water resources in the context of the 4.2 ka climatic event. Since 2022, with funding from Sapienza, I have been the Principal Investigator of the Bugs & Dung project, which aims to use sub-fossil insect remains to better understand the environment of Sumerian cities. The recently funded project SLOW SUMER: Repair, Reuse, Recycling, and Southern Mesopotamian Society in the Changing World of 2500-2000 BC (PRIN 2022) focuses on analyzing the practices of repair, reuse, and recycling in Sumerian society between 2500 and 2000 BC, thus filling a significant gap in current archaeological and philological research on these topics.
