RICCARDO REDAELLI, Ph.D.

PRESENT POSITION

Riccardo Redaelli is the Director of the Center for Research on the South System and the Wider Mediterranean System (CRiSSMA – since 2014) and Director of the Master in Middle Eastern Studies (MIMES since 2015), at the Catholic University of the S. Heart, Milano.

He is Professor of “History and Institutions of Asia” at the Faculty of Political and Social Sciences at the same University, where he teaches also “Post Conflict and Emergency Management” and “Geopolitics”.

In 2021, he became President of the Italian Association of International History (Società Italiana di Storia Internazionale - SISI).

He is currently also:

Pakistan (especially in Baluchistan); Afghanistan; Xinjiang; Iran; UAE (emirate of Ras al-Khaymah); Iraq; Libya (after the fall of Qaddhafi’s regime); Tunisia.

He also carried out extensive archival researches at the India Office and Library of London; the National Archives of London; the Provincial Archives of Quetta (Baluchistan – Pakistan); the Archives nationales d’Outre-Mer of Aix-en-Provence.

During his career, he organized a high number of International Conferences and Workshops both in Italy and abroad; he attended, as speaker, almost two hundred Seminars, Conferences, Workshops and Round-Tables in Europe, Middle East, Asia, and North-America (USA and Canada).
