Description of the project: This longitudinal intensive project aims to promote social inclusion among adolescents and young adults. Insights into the role of self-regulation and empathy in promoting social inclusion and overall well-being among young people in different contexts and social interactions are provided. Methodologically, emphasis is placed on the importance of within-person encouragement design (WPED) to evaluate causal relationships while keeping participants in their natural environments. In practical terms, participants will receive training in prosocial skills based on empirical research, aimed at cultivating socially inclusive behaviors.
